Summary:

• This Project Engineer / Estimator position supports our industrial projects team and is predominately site based at our clients' industrial manufacturing facilities in Central IL. Primary duties include the following: Working with client representatives, internal operations staff and subcontractors to review pending projects; developing detailed cost estimates, construction schedules and work plans based on site-walks, written scopes of work (SOW) and design documents; preparation of project proposals; project set-up; preparation of subcontracts and purchase orders, submittal review and ordering of materials. This position works closely with internal Foremen and Superintendents, Subcontractors and clients, and is required to have a detailed understanding of cost estimating, industrial construction operations, safety & quality programs. The ability to recognize priorities, and execute multiple work tasks without supervision, in a fast-paced industrial environment are critical skills for this position, as are attention to detail, flexibility and excellent written and verbal communication skills.

Key Functions:

- Project estimating & proposal writing: Project engineers/estimators conduct initial
 reviews of pending construction projects and are required to quickly assess risks and
 develop accurate cost estimates and work schedules, to be reviewed with the
 operations team. They then prepare detailed written project proposal packages to
 be submitted to the client.
- Project team: Project engineers/estimators form a critical part of our industrial projects team. They work closely with client reps to ensure project details are fully understood before they're under contract, and then with field staff and subcontractors to ensure projects are set-up for success and properly handed-off. Successful project



engineers/estimators may advance to become project managers, where they assume leadership responsibilities for increasingly complex construction projects.

- **Relationships and partnerships:** Project engineers/estimators develop and foster strategic relationships with clients, design partners, subcontractors and vendors that align with RCC's market sectors, business plans and corporate values.
- **Field Project Focus**: Project engineers/estimators require a detailed understanding of industrial construction (sitework, foundations, structural systems, MEPFP and Process systems, logistics & rigging), safety & quality.

- 3+ years' experience in the construction industry
 - Estimating and project management experience preferred
 - o Skilled trades and/or industrial manufacturing experience is helpful
